Support to the national Solid Waste Programme in Serbia

The Programme "PRO - Local Governance for People and Nature" is jointly implemented by the United Nations organisations in Serbia - UNOPS, UNICEF, UNFPA and UNEP, in cooperation with the Serbian Government, and with the financial support of the Government of Switzerland.

Considering that the Programme is designed to, among other things, enhance environmental governance and contribute to improving the quality of life of citizens, especially left-behind groups, in collaboration with the donor it was agreed to provide support to national Solid Waste Programme in Serbia, through this Programme within which the social measures to improve the position of informal waste pickers will be implemented.

The Solid Waste Programme will upgrade Serbia's waste management system through the closure of 15 municipal dumpsites and development of six regional waste management centres. Due to this, many informal waste pickers face the loss of their livelihoods, and in this regard the Programme "PRO - Local Governance for People and Nature" will provide support with the aim of improving the recovery of livelihoods and access to public services relevant to social inclusion (health, education and social protection).

At the policy level, new measures addressing the needs of waste pickers, mapped through a participatory process, will be included into the new Local Action Plan for Roma Inclusion 2024 - 2026 and Programme for Improvement of Social Protection. The local community will be engaged through focus groups with local businesses, waste pickers and local institutions. Findings will be base for adoption of the Operational Plan for social inclusion of waste pickers and their families. Moreover, the expert support will be provided for development of individual employment plans for each working age family member of the target group.

Training on career development will be organised for the working age family members of the priority group. At the policy level, new measures based on determined needs of waste pickers will be included into new Local Action Plan for Roma Inclusion 2024 - 2027.

LG Prijepolje has already conducted a needs assessment while the role of waste pickers will be defined and included into new Regional Waste Management Plan covering Prijepolje, Priboj, Nova Varoš and Sjenica.

The FS will be engaged full-time. The training for self-employment and better employability of the target group will be organised in accordance with determined needs of working age family members. The assessment of waste pickers needs was conducted in cooperation with PUC Komunalac while new measures will be included into inclusive systemic public policy.

OBRENOVAC		Total Value 44,304 EUR	Besides establishment of LCM, the LG Obrenovac will engage two FS i.e. one for full-time and one municipal employee who already works with vulnerable groups. The focus groups with local businesses will be organised in order to determine potential for training or employment of the target group. Due to large number of listed waste pickers` households, a thorough survey will be conducted to determine the exact number of the members from the priority group. Based on the determined needs of waste pickers, the new measures will be included into the Local Development Programme.
